**Transport:** A pre-conference field trip visiting loess deposits in eastern South Island will provide transport from Christchurch to Lake Tekapo on Sunday 12 February. The bus is available for return transport of conference attendees to Christchurch on Friday 17 February. A commercial bus service is available from Christchurch or Queenstown to Lake Tekapo, see <http://www.intercity.co.nz/>. A range of car rental options is offered at Christchurch airport, or from within the city.

**Accommodation:** Lake Tekapo is a tourist town on the shores of Lake Tekapo in the Mackenzie Basin and a wide range of accommodation exists. Conference organisers have booked two holiday homes which will accommodate 13 people (total), with a mix of individual rooms (double-bed) and twin-share options, for \$45 per person per night (first come, first served for a place in these).
